

# GISHALI FLOWER PARK PROJECT

- GISHALI sector (Rwamagana District) was identified to have ideal conditions in terms of altitude, existence of sufficient water and its location near by Kigali.
- The GISHALI flower park project has been designed by Government of Rwanda to facilitate investment in the nascent floriculture industry, to increase export of non-traditional and high value products. This initiative is implemented on a public private partnership basis
- The PHASE I project is developed on 35 ha in GISHALI, only 60km from Kigali at 1500m ASL to produce greenhouse premium intermediate standard roses for export market.
- The PHASE II is an expansion planned on 65 ha.
- The construction of building and support infrastructure is complete, the flower production on PHASE I has started, and it is expected to produce 41 million stems per year at a projected selling price of 0.08 euro per stem.





The Government of Rwanda is looking for a partner to come in as equity stake at least 25 percent of the total investment. The project is proposed to be developed over two phases to reach 100 ha in Gishali. Other potential sites have been mapped and profiled for potential flower investors.

The feasibility, the EIA and the business plan are available to interested investors.
