## I. Introduction

This report is composed by statistical data for agricultural exports and re- exports for July 2020. It provides also combined data for calendar year January-July 2020 in comparison with same period of 2019.

During this month of July 2020, total export revenues were \$ 29,721,623 compared to \$ 40,328,088 in 2019 the same period, representing a decrease of 26%. This large drop in term of revenues can be explained by the reduction of informal cross border trade due to issues of corona virus pandemic diseases and lockdown measures. All informal cross border trade were converted into simplified formal trade where only less than 20% of traders managed to combine their good to be sold in bulk to DRC. The commodities like flowers, forest products, fish, dairy products and cereals were not affected by the COVID 19 as it realized an increase in export revenues by 216%; 58%; 54%; 24% and 9% respectively. These product are easy to be sold in grouped form adopted within the region trade.

The cumulative achievement from January-July 2020 revenues was \$ 213,258,860 against \$ 257,181,815 recorded in the same period of 2019, representing a decrease of 17.08%. While some commodities in this period like flowers, tea, vegetables oil, fish were not hardly affected by the COVID 19 as it realized an increase in export revenues by 31.11%; 12.60%; 8.88%; and 4.75% respectively.

Out of \$ 29,721,623 revenues generated in July 2020, the re-exports of Nontraditional commodities mainly vegetables dominated by tomato paste; fruits dominated by fruit juice and grape; cereals dominated by rice, spaghetti and biscuits; cooking oils dominated by palm oil, virgin olive oil and sunflower oil; fish dominated by sardine, tilapia and Mackerel. Sugar dominated by brown sugar from Guatemalan that re- exported to DRC.

Despite the new tea factories that introduced their teas in production system, the heavy rain caused flood that affected Mulindi , Pfunda and SORWATHE tea plantation with negative impact of their green leaf production. The late fertilizer supply cause by COVID 19 which affected the transport influenced timely application of fertilizer affected July production compared to last year 2019. More than 1000MT of fertilizer were not applied. All these factors combined with early dry season in June reduced production by 20, 23%.

The quality of produced tea in Mata, Rutsiro, Gatare and Cyato for both BI and cooperative production are below the recommendable quality of 65 % to produce quality Made tea. This should be behind the low quality and selling prices observed in these factories. In order to preserve the quality of Rwanda tea, green leaf handling should be given special attention mainly during tea plucking, weighting, loading, and offloading. The feeder roads should also be given special consideration.

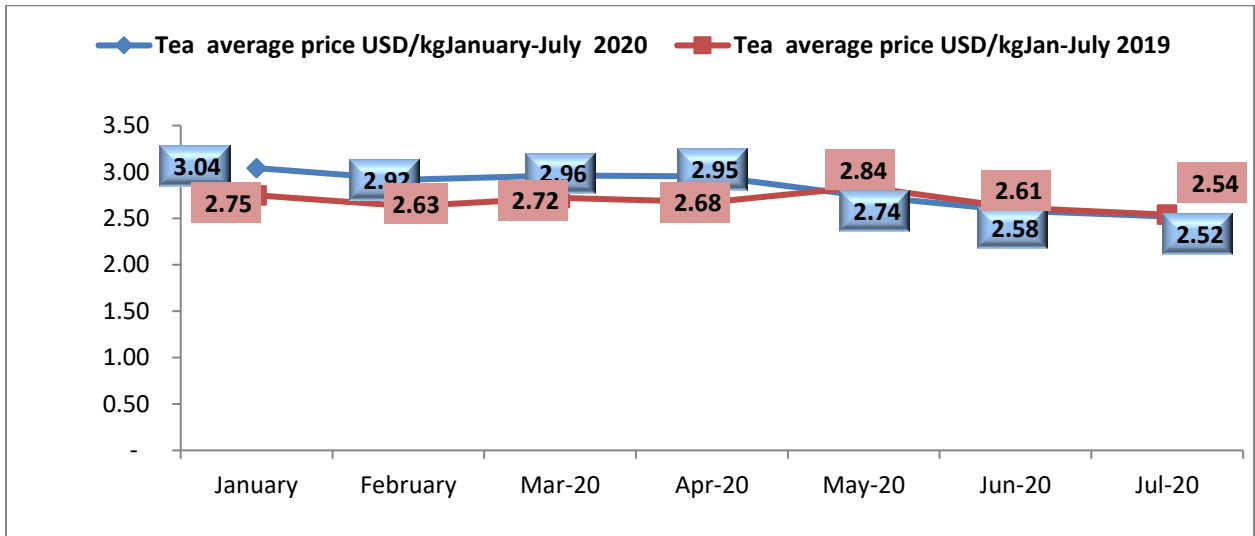

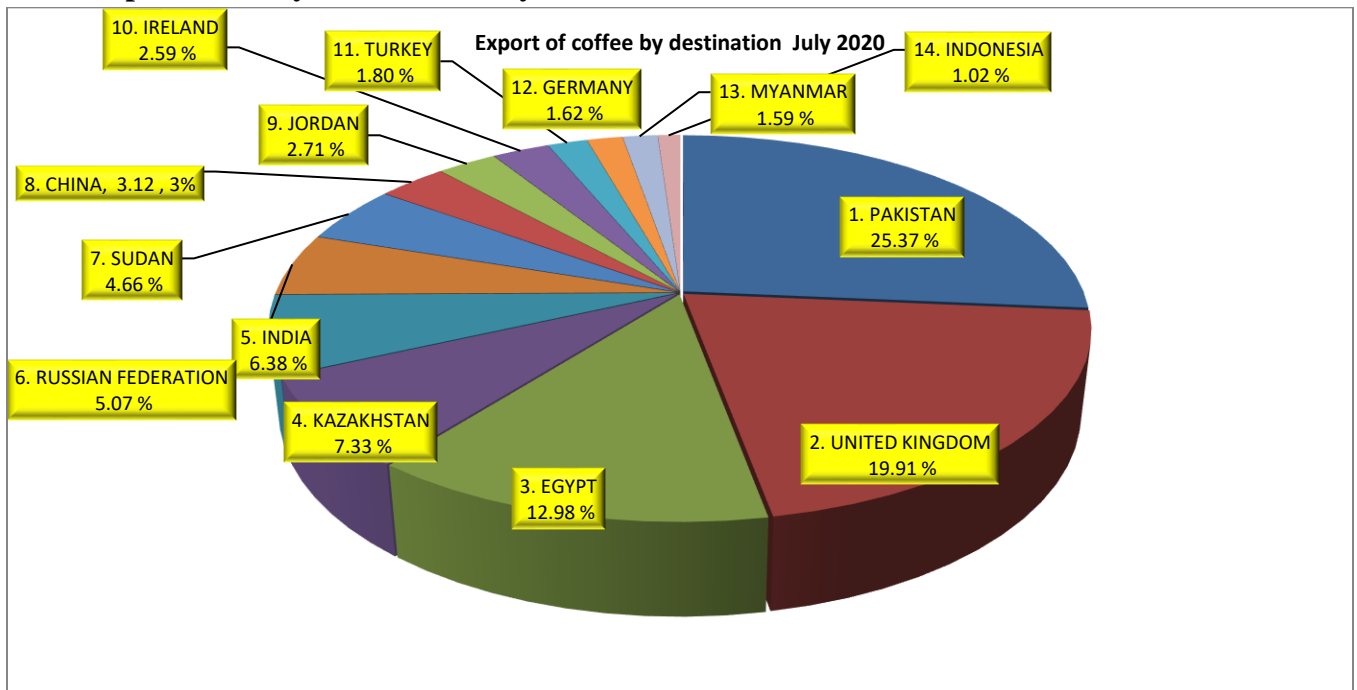

**II.3.5. Export of tea by destination July 2019**

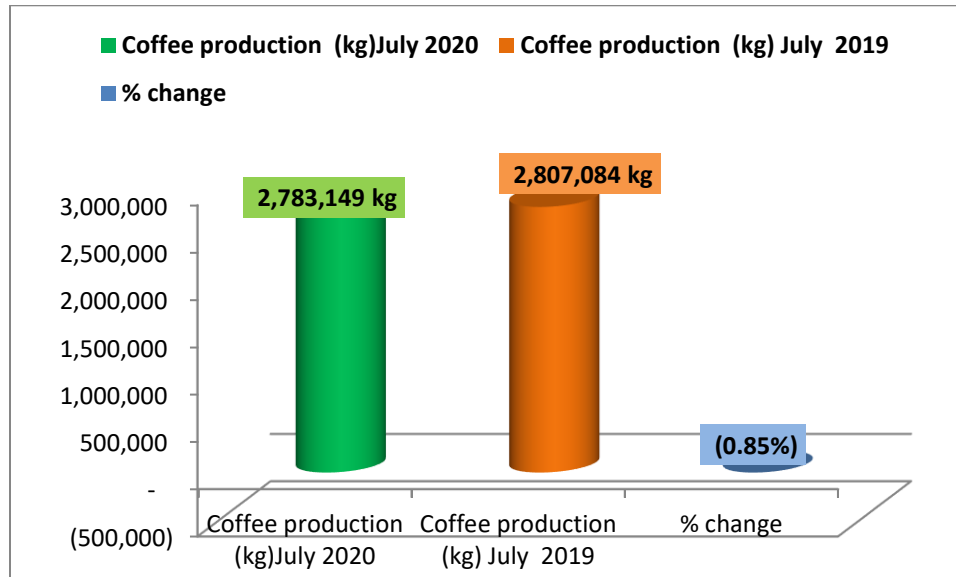

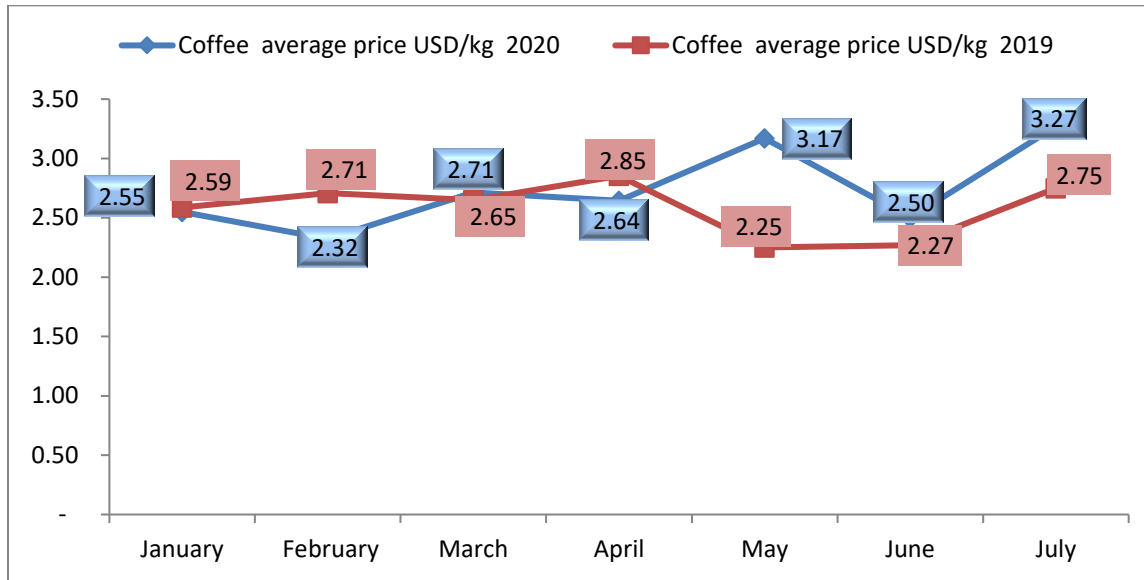

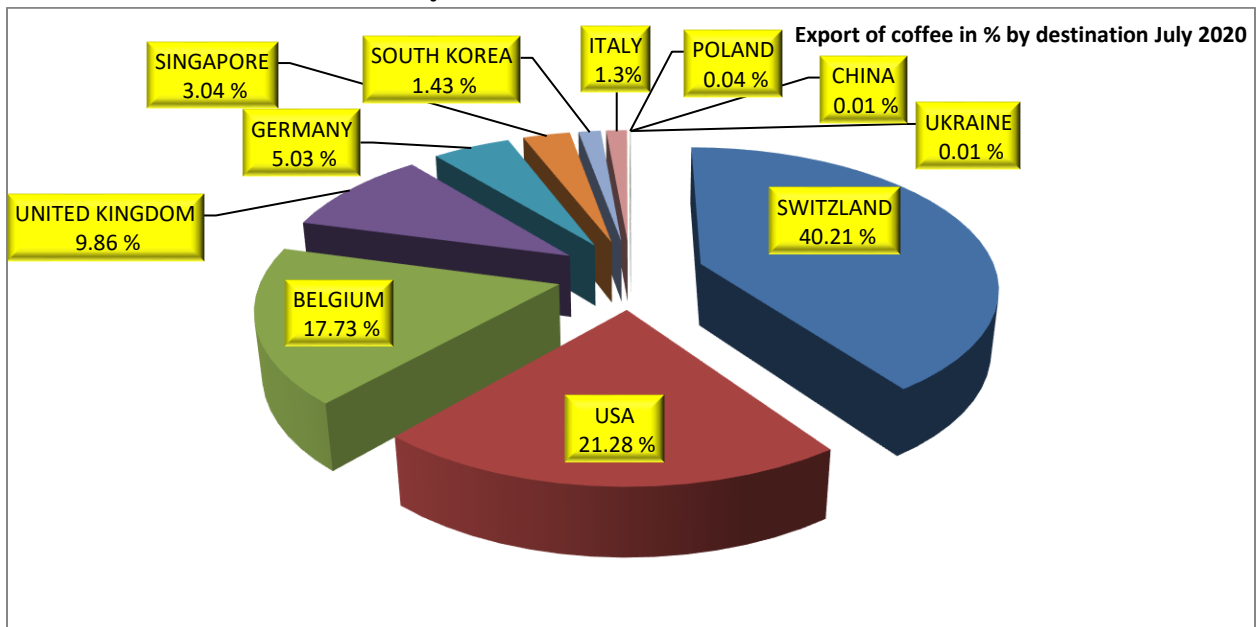
