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I. Introduction

This report is composed by statistical data for agricultural exports and re- exports for May 2020. It provides also combined data for fiscal year July 2019-May 2020 in comparison with same period of 2018-2019.

During May 2020, total export revenues were \$ 24,804,195 compared to \$ 37,393,981 in 2019 the same period, representing a decrease of 34 %. This large drop in term of revenues can be attributed to the reduction of informal cross border trade due to issues of COVID 19 pandemic and lockdown measures. All informal cross border trade were converted into simplified formal trade where only less than 20% of traders managed to combine their good to be sold in bulk to DRC. The commodities like roots and tubers (cassava), banana for cooking and re -exported fish were not hardly affected by the COVID 19. The three commodities increased in export revenues by 26.91%; 21.37% and 5% respectively.

The cumulative revenues achievement from July 2019 to May 2020 was \$ 393,466,559 against \$ 432,968.331 recorded in the same period of 2018-2019, representing a decrease of 9%.

Out of \$ 24,388,272 generated in May 2020, the re–exports of Nontraditional commodities mainly vegetables dominated by tomato paste; fruit juice, cereals composed by rice, wheat and biscuits; cooking oils and fish occupy 44% equivalent to \$ 10,810,550.

New tea plantation (Gatare, Cyato and Rugabano); and other maturing tea from new tea factories contributed to this performance. In addition to that good practices in tea growing, training

organized for members of cooperatives were also contributing to this growth. Most importantly good rains registered over this period contribute significantly to this performance.

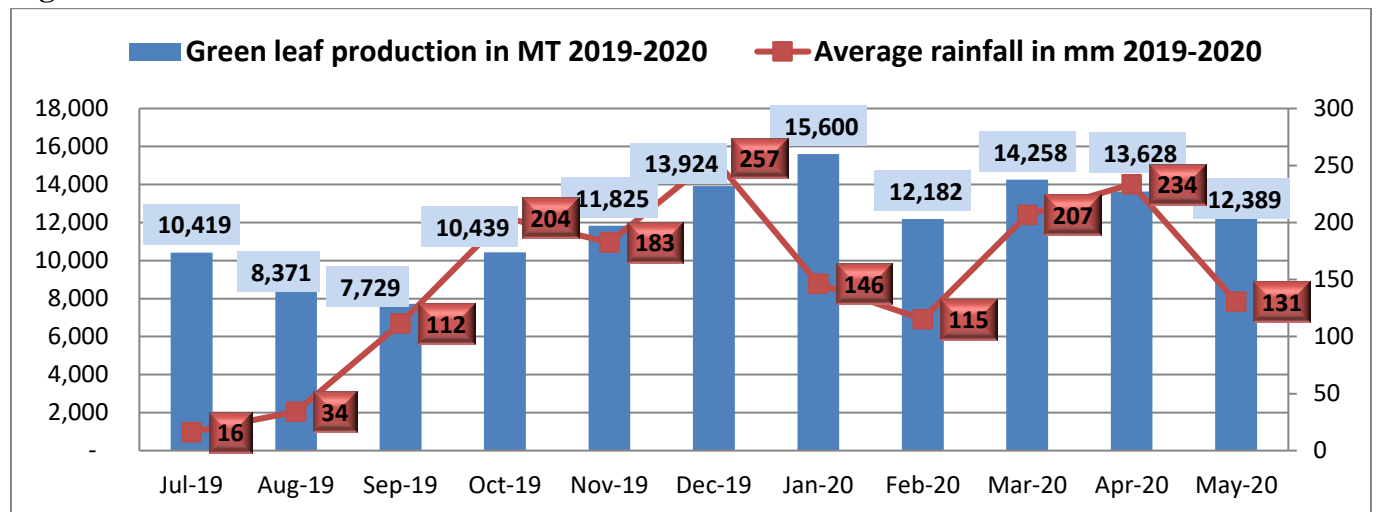
II.1.3. Rainfall July 2019-May 2020

The good performance achieved by tea sector during the year 2019-2020 is partly the result of good climatic conditions that prevailed in the last two quarters of 2019-2020 (October 2019 – March 2020) where average quantity of rains registered amounts 1,112 mm/month.

The chart below highlights the correlation between green leaf production and quantity of rains registered.

Pfunda BI and its cooperative production quality turned around 60. This quality is one of the justification of low prices observed in this factory . In order to preserve the quality of Rwanda tea, green leaf handling should be given special attention mainly during tea plucking, weighting, loading, and offloading. Almost 15 cooperatives and Industrial bloc are below the recommendable quality of 65 % for good quality tea leaves

The increment of 10.39% came from timely applied fertilizer, training provided to tea pickers and current expansion of factory processing capacities. The table above shows that Gatare, Rutsiro and Muganza-Kivu tea factories performed well with increase of 57.84%, 41.16% and 36.94% respectively compared to last year same period.

II.3. Tea export sales

II.3.1. Export sales May 2020/Auction and Direct sales

Export sales were performed through auctioning made tea at the Mombasa international market, and by direct sales with private buyers. Auction sales revenue represented 54% of total values while the direct sales revenues represented 46% of total values. The problem here is that the price of Direct sale has decreased while its volume has increased. Usually, the price of direct sales is higher than the price of auction sales.

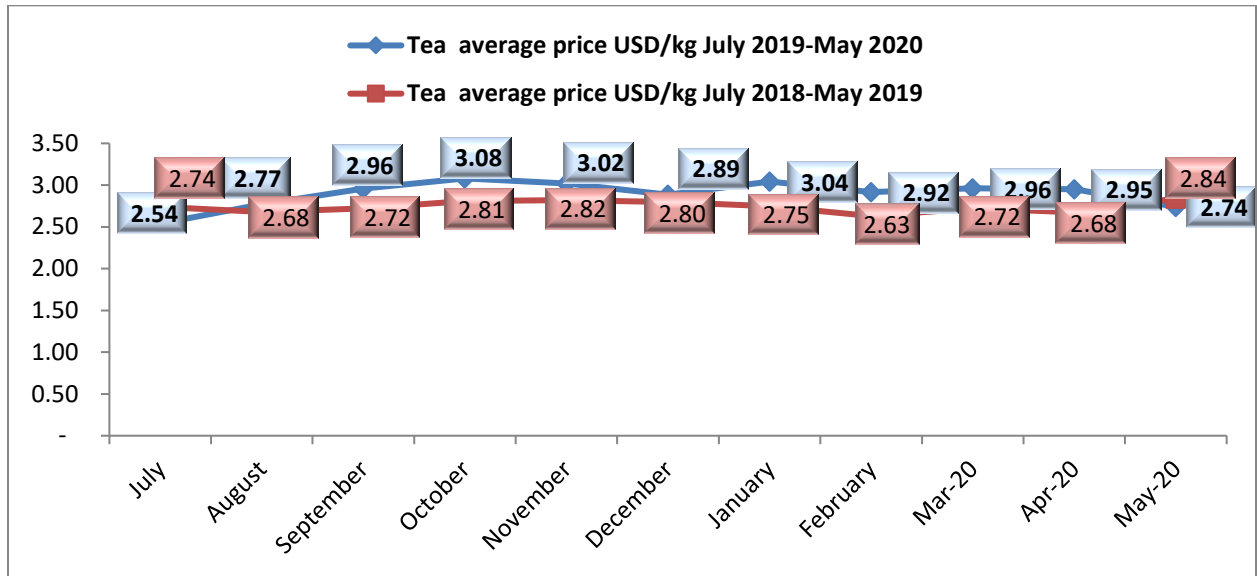

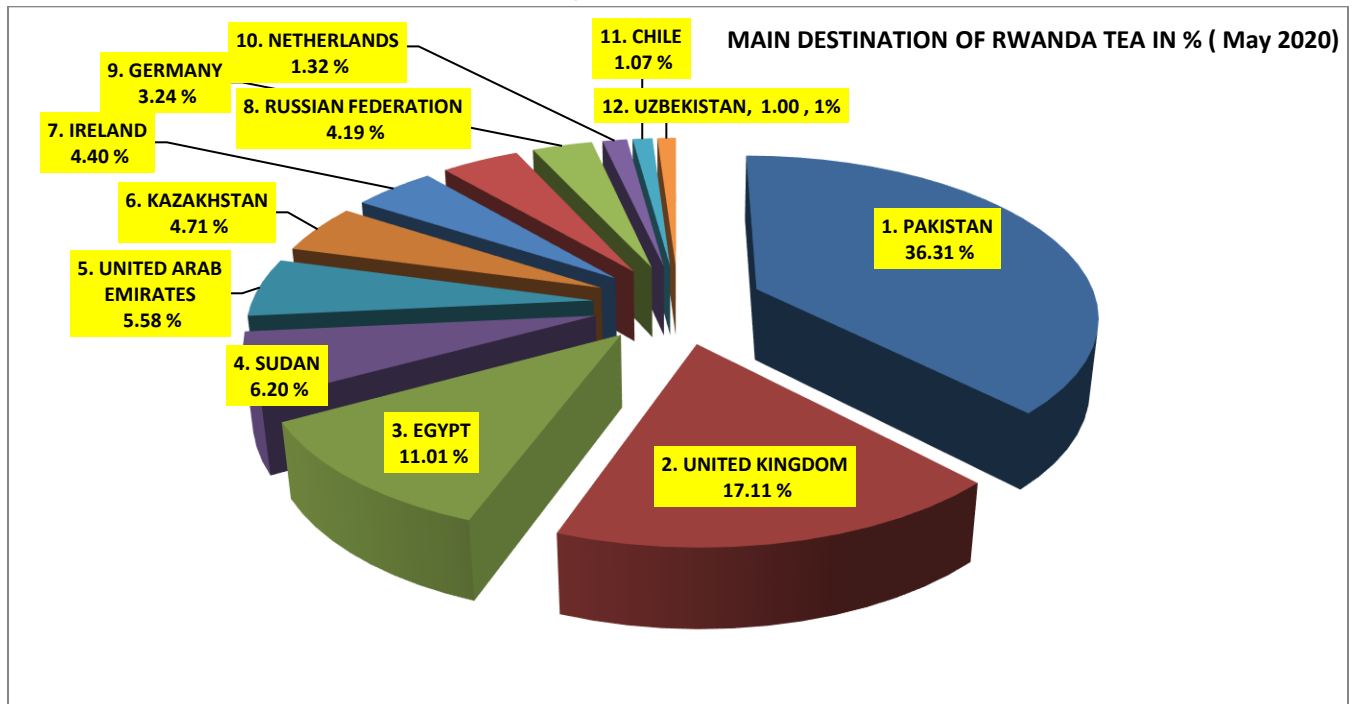

Apart the months of July 2019 and May 2020, good prices were registered in others periods of the year.

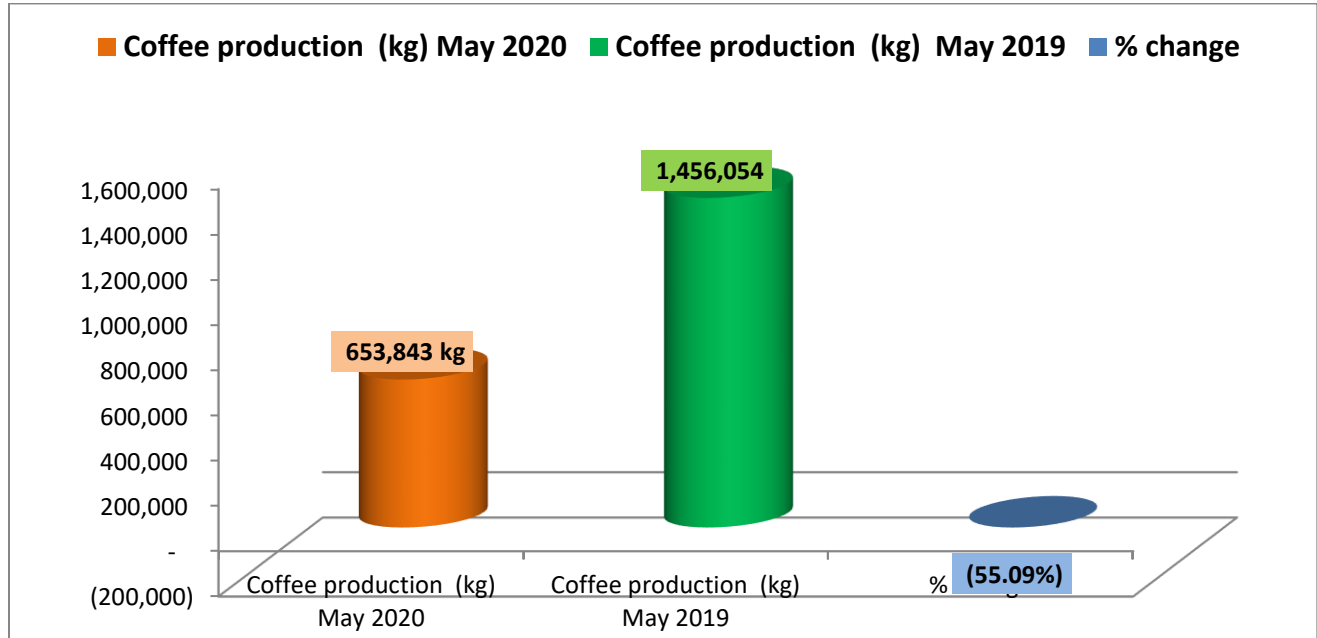
II.3.5. Destination of Rwanda Tea May 2020

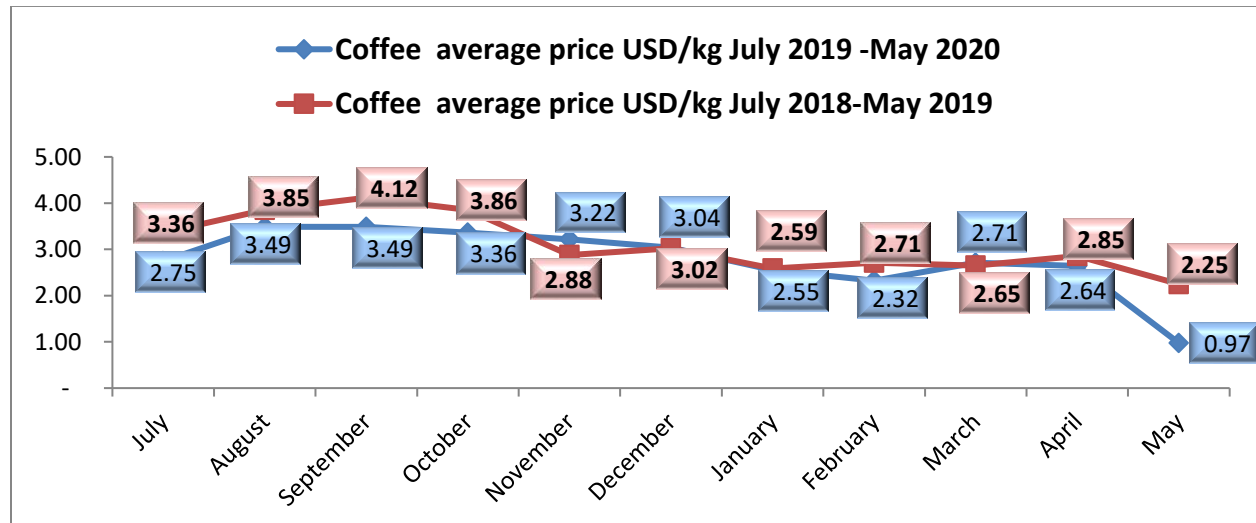

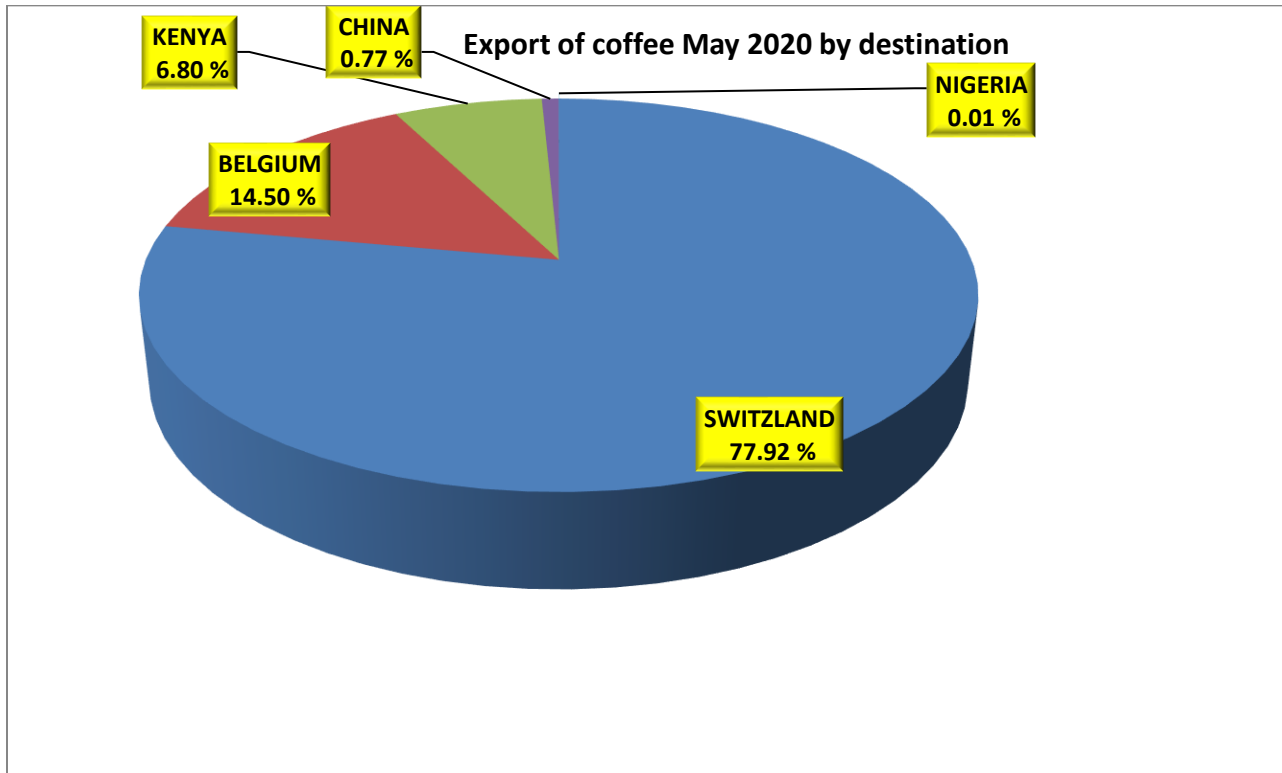
