**SEPTEMBER 2020 & QUARTER ONE 2020-2021 STASTICAL REPORT**

OCTOBER 2020

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## I. Introduction

This report is composed by statistical data for agricultural exports and re- exports for September 2020. It provides also combined data for calendar year January-September 2020 in comparison with same period of 2019 and fiscal year July-September 2020 in comparison with July-September 2019.

During this month of September 2020, total export revenues were \$ 34,262,447 compared to \$ 39,172,483 in 2019 the same period, representing a decrease of 13%. This large drop in term of revenues can be explained by the reduction of informal cross border trade due to issues of corona virus pandemic diseases and limited movement of people. All informal cross border trade was converted into simplified formal trade where only less than 20% of traders managed to combine their good to be sold in bulk to DRC. The commodities like Fish, flowers, roots and tubers, Sugar, and tea were not hardly affected by the COVID 19 as it realized an increase in export revenues by 143%; 70%; 23%; 20% and 9% respectively.

The cumulative achievement in fiscal year July-September 2020 revenues was \$ 93,054,421 against \$ 114,871,074 recorded in the same period of 2019, representing a decrease of 19%.

The cumulative achievement in calendar year (January-September) 2020 revenues was \$ 276,591,659 against \$ 335,068,965 in 2019 representing decrease of 17.45%

Out of \$ 34,262,447 revenues generated in this September, \$ 11,098,200 are re-exports of Nontraditional commodities mainly vegetables dominated by tomato paste; fruits dominated by fruit juice; cereals dominated by rice, spaghetti and biscuits; cooking oils dominated by palm oil, virgin olive oil and sunflower oil; fish dominated by sardine, tilapia and Mackerel. Sugar dominated by brown sugar from India, Thailand and Brazil all equivalent at 32, 4% of the total exports

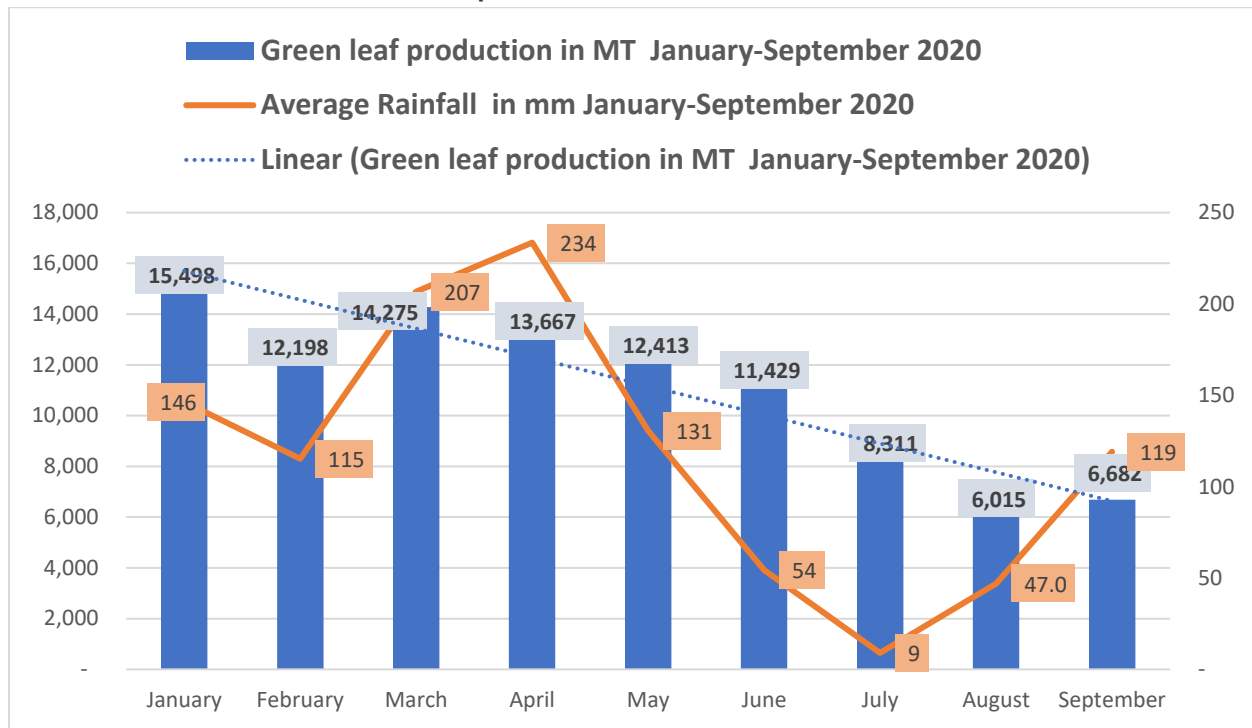
Despite the drought experienced mainly in July and August, the cumulative September 2020 performance in green leaf compared with 2019 was positive. This was influenced by good performances of new tea plantations like Rutsiro, Muganza-Kivu and Gatare which the production increase as the years go by and to good rain registered 2020 (1062 mm) in comparison with 2019 (780 mm). In general new factories performed well mainly Rutsiro, Muganza-Kivu and Gatare.

It is true that the impact of rains on tea green leaf production cannot be neglected, as tea green leaves tend to increase in volume when the quantity of rains goes up and decrease when quantity of rain is diminishing. Indeed, when we compare the quantity of rainfalls registered in 2020 (1,062 mm) to that of 2019 (780 mm), one can observe that the period of 2019 registered lower rains than that of 2020. This confirms the lower production of green leaves obtained compared to that of last year same period.

### II.1.4. Correlation between Green leaf production and rainfall 2020/2019



From July to September 2020, the quantities of rain recorded were very low in comparison with other months of the year. This had a negative impact on the production of green leaf in quarter one 2020-2021.

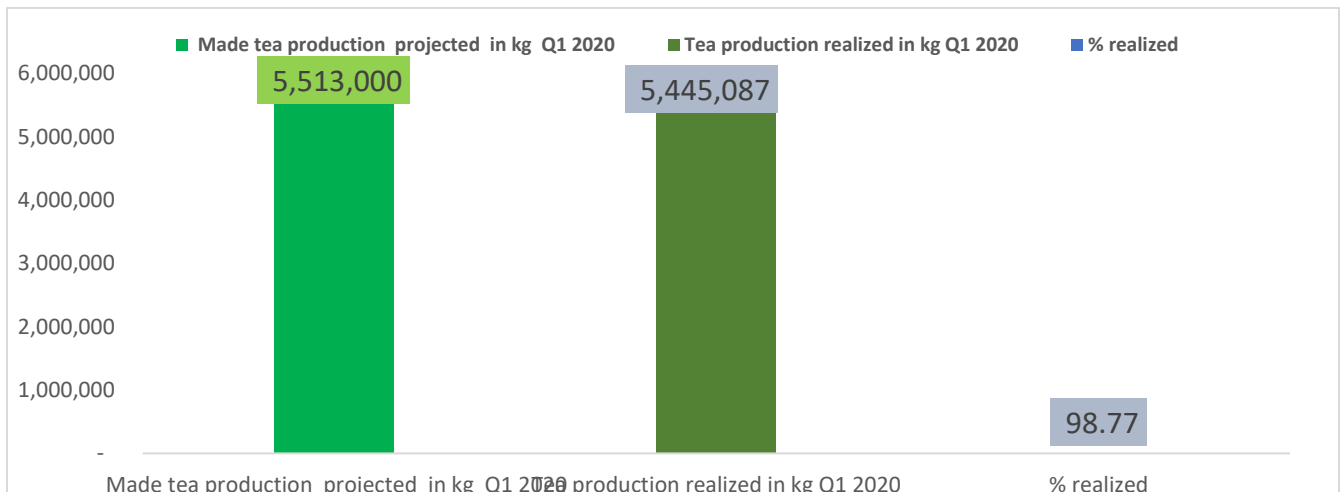

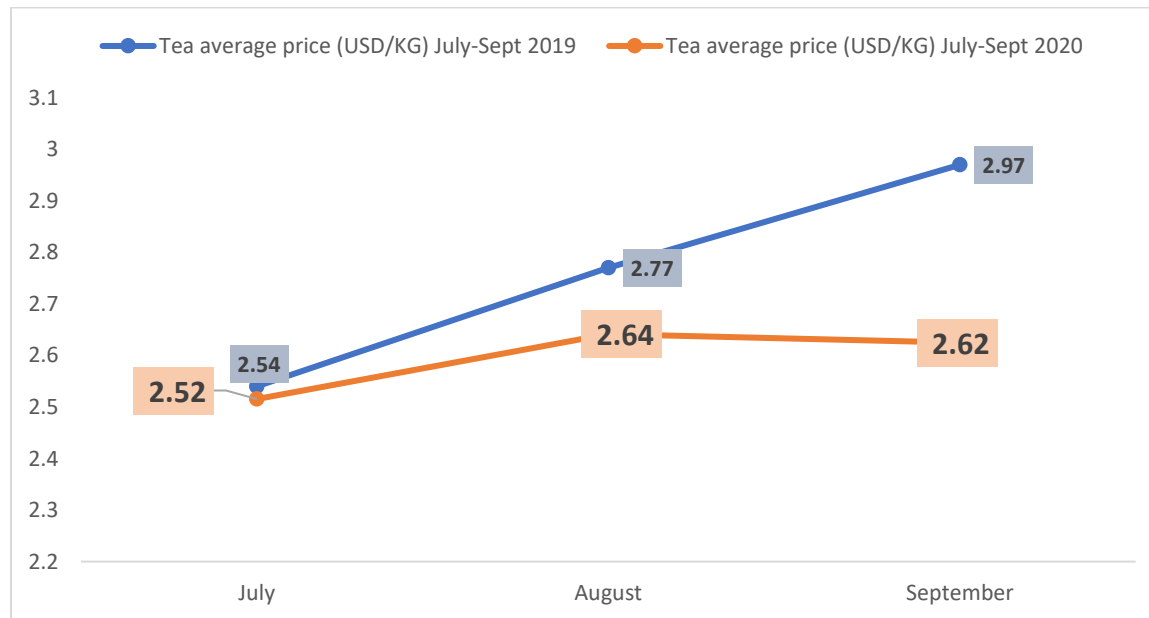

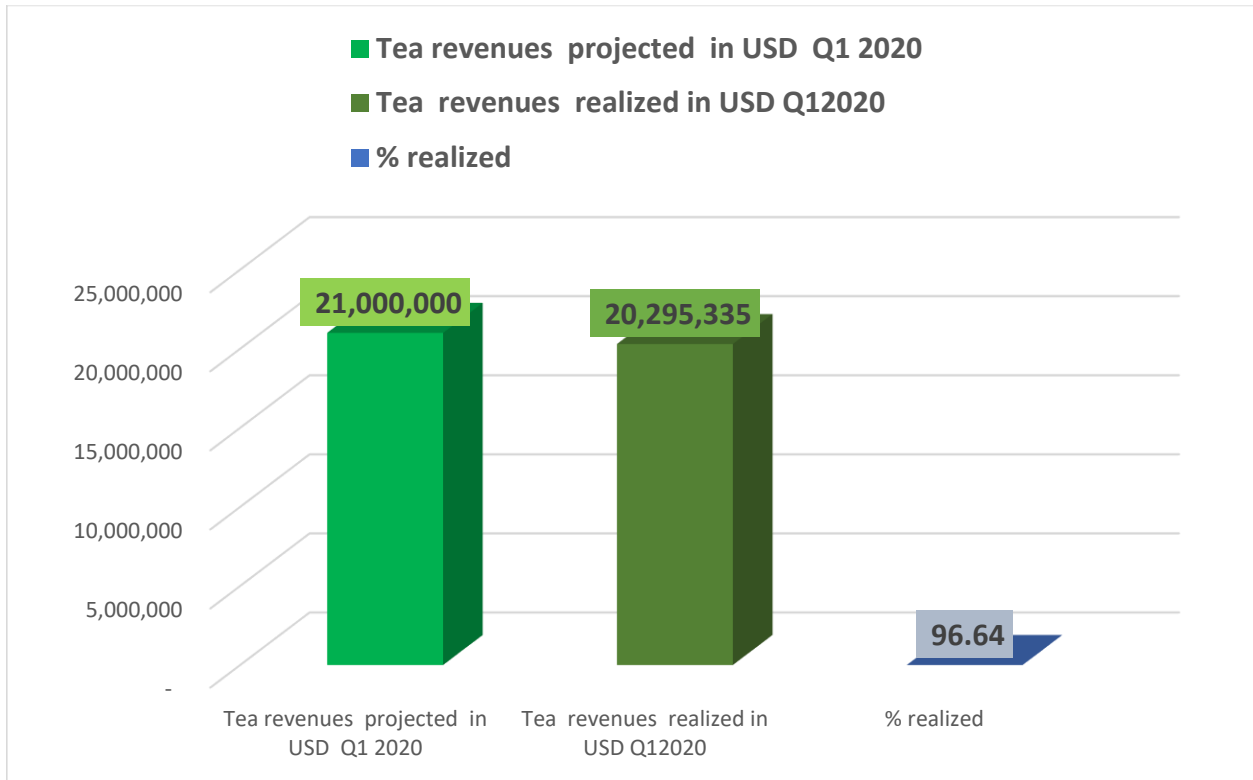

### II.3.4. Trend of quarter one tea average prices (USD/kg) July-Sept 2019-2020/2020-2021

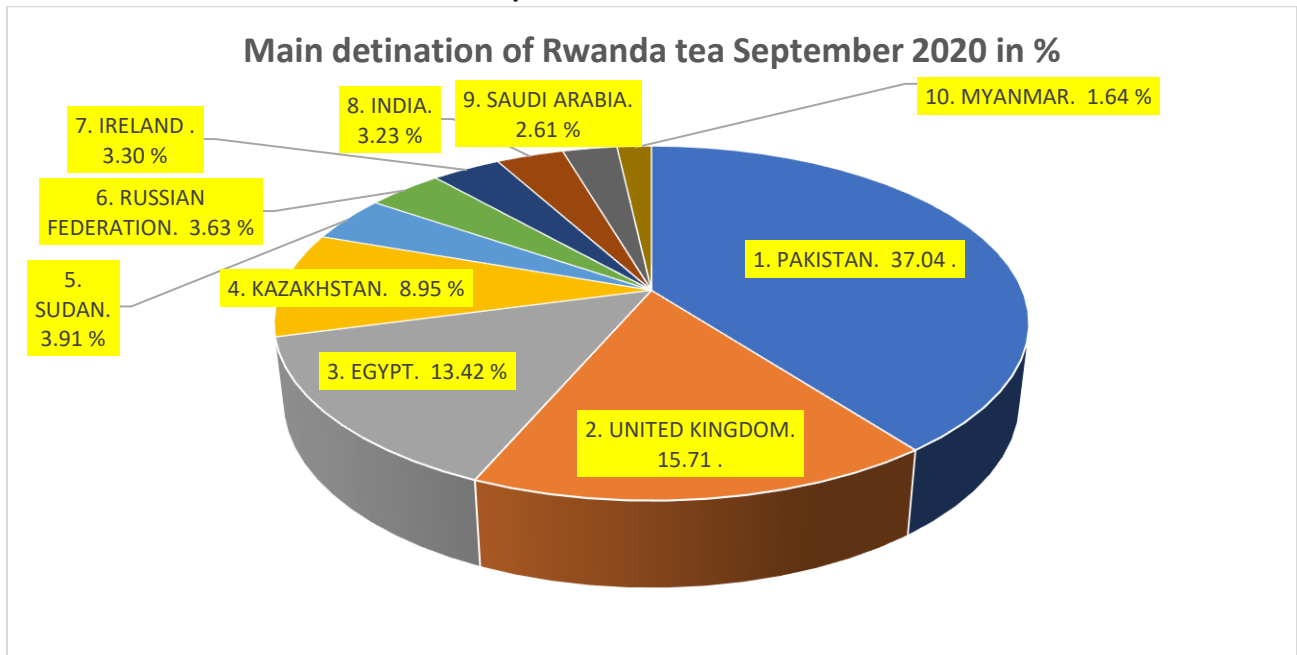


II.3.5. Realized / projected revenues of Made Tea quarter one 2020-2021

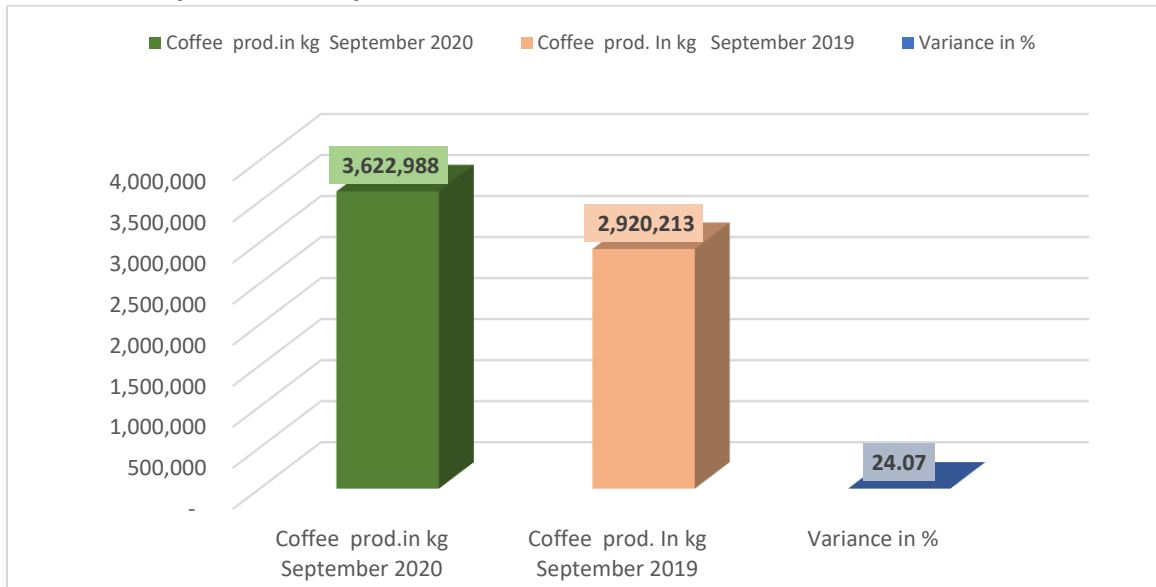

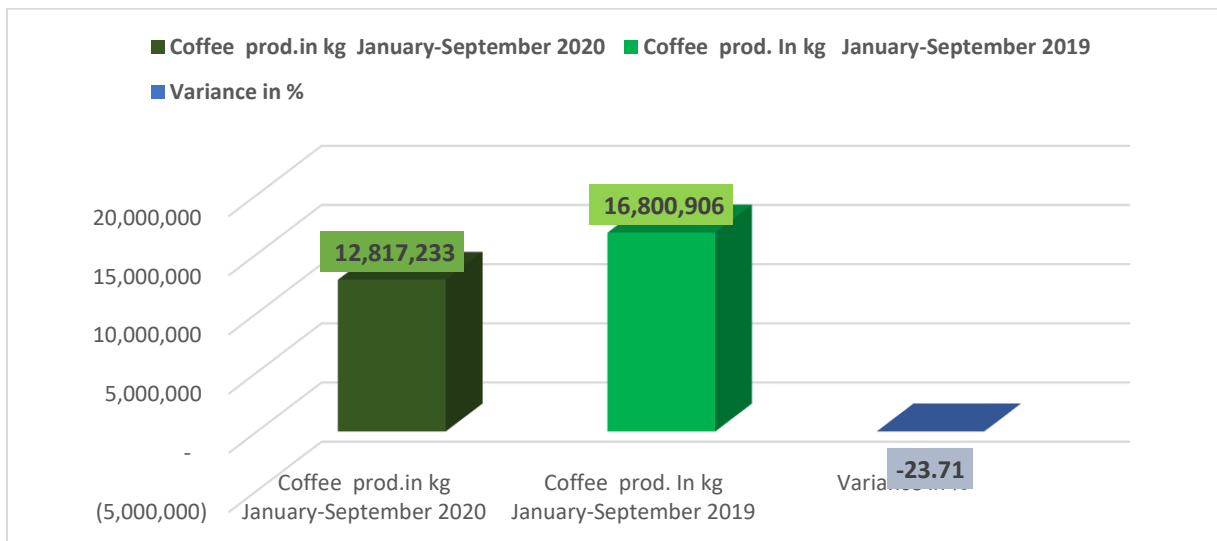
The production of 2,644,823 kg full washed coffee represents 73% of total production, Semi washed coffee of 343,126 kg represents 9.47% of total production, triage at 335,081 kg represents 9.25%, Nature coffee at 187,491 kg represents 5.18%; Honey at 24,234 kg represents 0.67%; coffee roasted at 21,050 kg represents 0.58% and Robusta at 67,183 kg represents 1.85%. The production of high volume of full washed coffee is

an indication of coffee zoning functionalities where farmer are supplying cherries to CWS to get Good quality coffee for international market.

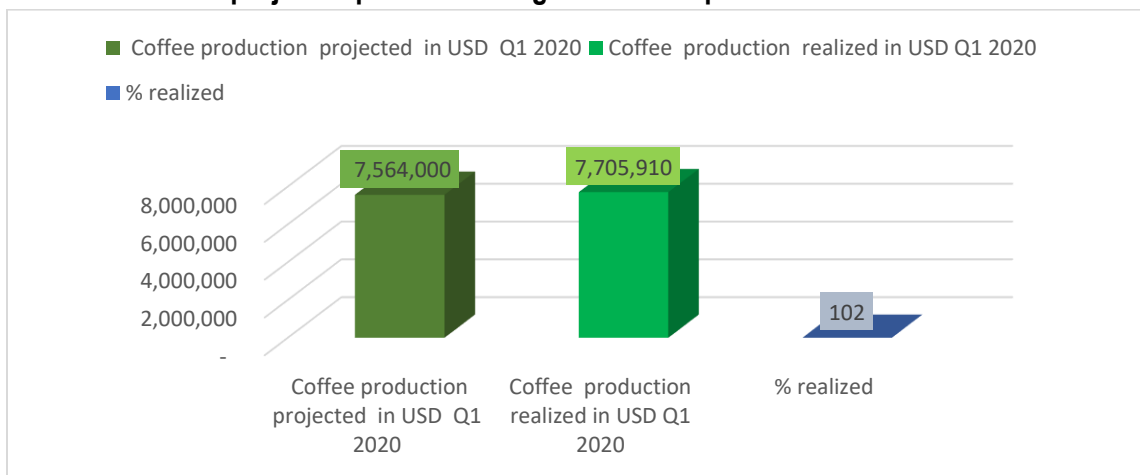

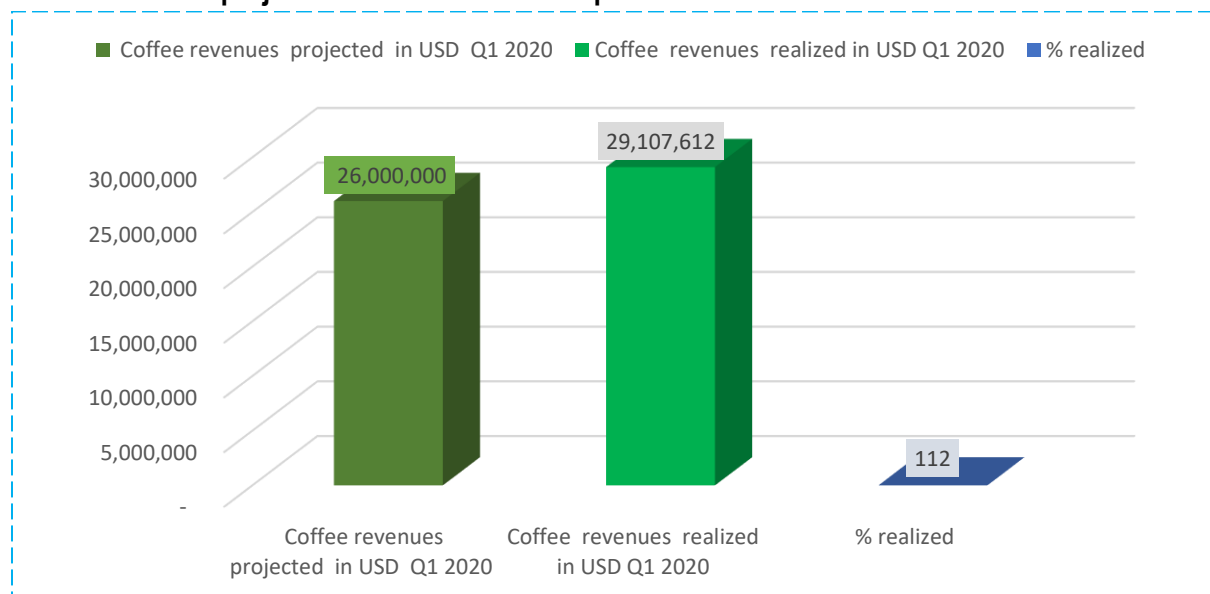

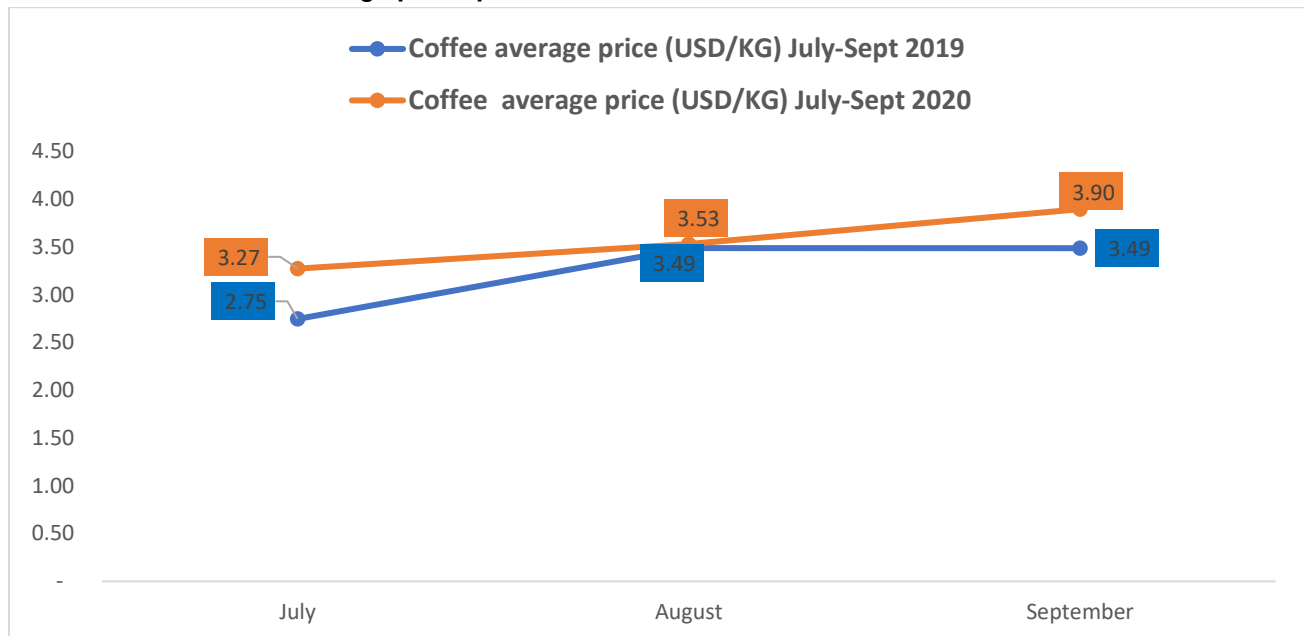
